The American Revolutionary War, 1775-1783

In total, around 230,000 soldiers served in the Continental Army, though never more than 48,000 soldiers at one time. The Continental Army was supplemented by about 145,000 militiamen. How many Continental Soldiers Died in the Revolutionary War? Around 8,000 Continental soldiers were killed in battle and 25,000 were wounded.

Joseph Warren is an American physician who played a leading role in American Patriot organizations in Boston in the early days of the American Revolution, eventually serving as President of the revolutionary Massachusetts Provincial Congress. Warren enlisted Paul Revere and William Dawes on April 18, 1775, to leave Boston and spread the alarm that the British garrison in Boston was setting out to raid the town of Concord and arrest rebel leaders John Hancock and Samuel Adams.
